

## BUTINOX Sopp- og Algefjerner

### Product description

#### Type

Biocidal concentrate. Fungicidal and disinfectant properties.

#### Features and benefits

Combats fungi and algal growth on fouled surfaces. Does not attack plastic, steel, paint, etc. in the recommended use concentration. Avoid spraying this agent directly onto plants. Any spills may be rinsed off with clean water.

#### Recommended use

Used to prevent fungal and algal growth on untreated, stained or painted surfaces before painting or staining. Can also be used to remove fungi and algae on surfaces that are not to be treated, eg roof tiles, paving stones, masonry and the like. Can also be used for disinfection of surfaces; indoors and outdoors.

#### Application equipment / methods

**BUTINOX Sopp- og Algefjerner** is applied with a low pressure pump, or brush in smaller areas. Wear skin and eye protection.

#### Consumption

10–20 m<sup>2</sup>/liter ready mix. Thinning: 1:10 with water.  
Used for indoor disinfection: Thinning: 1:25 with water.

#### Thinner

#### Conditions during application

**BUTINOX Sopp- og Algefjerner** has the best effect on microorganisms when the substrate temperature is above +15 °C.

## Directions for use

Contaminated surfaces to be washed with **BUTINOX Husvask og Kraftvask**. Rinse thoroughly and allow the surface to dry before applying **BUTINOX Sopp- og Algefjerner**.

On heavily affected surfaces, thorough washing is required before application of **BUTINOX Sopp- og Algefjerner**.

Thinning: 1 part **BUTINOX Sopp- og Algefjerner** to 10 parts water. On heavily fouled surfaces: 1 part **BUTINOX Sopp- og Algefjerner** to 5 parts water.

Moisten the entire surface and allow it to dry. Do not rinse off.

## Storage

In storage and in transport keep the container frost free and upright.

## Disposal of waste

Detergent must not be discharged into drains, but to a reception centre for dangerous waste.
